

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 649

11 A congregate care facility may require an essential caregiver  
12 to assume of the costs of any of the following:

13 (1) Providing personal protective equipment for himself  
14 or herself to allow the essential caregiver to safely provide  
15 in-person physical or emotional support. Personal protective  
16 equipment provided by the congregate care facility may not  
17 reduce the personal protective equipment available to the  
18 employees and staff of the congregate care facility.

19 (2) Meeting the additional safety requirements  
20 established by the congregate care facility under section 4.
