9 Section 1. Section 1901(c) and (d)(2) of Title 75 of the
10 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
11 § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

13 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
14 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
15 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
16 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
17 registration:

- 18 (1) Hospital.
- 19 (2) Humane society.
- 20 (3) Nonprofit youth center.
- 21 (4) American Red Cross.
- 22 (5) Church.
- 23 (6) Girl Scouts of America.
- 24 (7) Boy Scouts of America.
- 25 (8) Salvation Army.
- 26 (9) Duly chartered posts of national veterans'
27 organizations.
- 28 (10) Young Men's Christian Association.
- 29 (11) Young Men's Hebrew Association.
- 30 (12) Young Women's Christian Association.
- 31 (13) Young Women's Hebrew Association.
- 32 (14) Jewish Community Center.
- 33 (15) Nonprofit corporations of musical marching groups
34 of youths.
- 35 (16) Any person who is retired and receiving social

1 security or other pension and whose total annual income does
2 not exceed \$19,200. Unless the retired person is physically
3 or mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the retired
4 person shall be the principal driver of the vehicle but may
5 from time to time authorize another person to drive the
6 vehicle in his or her stead.

7 (17) Any veteran who lost a limb or eye or who became
8 partially paralyzed while serving in the armed forces of the
9 United States.

10 (18) A person who, as a member of the armed forces of
11 the United States, was captured by the enemy during World War
12 I, World War II, the Korean Emergency, the Vietnam Conflict
13 or in a future armed conflict for which the Department of
14 Defense authorizes a campaign medal.

15 (19) Any person who has been awarded the Congressional
16 Medal of Honor.

17 (20) Nonprofit organizations which care for or otherwise
18 provide services for the elderly or the infirm.

19 (21) Nonprofit organizations which principally serve
20 mentally or physically handicapped or disabled persons.

21 (22) Nonprofit mobile aviation museum.

22 (23) Nonprofit corporations that provide ambulance or
23 emergency medical services.

24 (24) An active volunteer first responder who does not
25 receive compensation for the volunteer's service to an
26 emergency medical services company, a volunteer fire company
27 or a volunteer rescue service. The active volunteer first
28 responder shall be the principal driver of the vehicle but
29 may from time to time authorize another person to drive the
30 vehicle in his or her stead. For the purposes of this
31 paragraph, the terms "emergency medical services company,"
32 "volunteer fire company" and "volunteer rescue service" shall
33 have the meanings given to them in 35 Pa.C.S. § 7363
34 (relating to definitions).

35 (d) Limitations.--

36 * * *

37 (2) Only one passenger car or truck with a registered
38 gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds may be registered
39 to any person under the provisions of subsection (b) (4) and
40 subsection (c) (16), (17), (18) [and], (19) and (24).

42 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
