1 Amend Bill, page 4, by inserting between lines 2 and 3

2 Section 2103-E. Retention of records related to COVID-19 by the
3 General Assembly.

4 A caucus or chamber of the General Assembly that was party to
5 litigation in Federal or State court related to COVID-19, the
6 order or actions of an executive agency in response to COVID-19
7 shall preserve all records pertaining to litigation in
8 possession of the caucus or chamber of the General Assembly for
9 a period of 10 years after the order is terminated by executive
10 order, proclamation or operation of law, including records
11 created concerning the cost of litigation. All contracts entered
12 into and costs and expenses incurred due to any litigation
13 covered under this section shall be published on the General
14 Assembly's publicly accessible Internet website. Information
15 published under this section shall be updated monthly.
