8 (b) Public information.--The following records are public
9 records and shall be subject to the Right-to-Know Law:

10 (1) Applications for permits submitted by medical
11 marijuana organizations.

12 (2) The names, business addresses and medical
13 credentials of practitioners authorized to provide
14 certifications to patients to enable them to obtain and use
15 medical marijuana in this Commonwealth. All other
16 practitioner registration information shall be confidential
17 and exempt from public disclosure under the Right-to-Know
18 Law.

19 (3) Information relating to penalties or other
20 disciplinary actions taken against a medical marijuana
21 organization or practitioner by the department for violation
22 of this act.

23 (4) The names of the individuals retained by the
24 department to review applications submitted by a medical
25 marijuana organization seeking a permit.
