3 Section 3.1. Personal Protective Equipment Logistics and
4 Warehousing Advisory Board.

5 (a) Establishment.--The Personal Protective Equipment
6 Logistics and Warehousing Advisory Board is established as an
7 advisory board in the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency.
8 The advisory board shall meet within 30 days of the effective
9 date of this section and every 30 days thereafter until the
10 expiration of this section.

11 (b) Membership.--The advisory board shall consist of the
12 following members:

13 (1) The Governor or a designee.

14 (2) The Adjutant General or a designee, who shall serve
15 as chair of the advisory board.

16 (3) The Secretary of Health or a designee.

17 (4) The Secretary of General Services or a designee.

18 (5) The Director of the Pennsylvania Emergency
19 Management Agency.

20 (6) An individual with at least five years experience in
21 business logistics, warehousing or storage appointed by the
22 Majority Leader of the Senate.

23 (7) An individual with at least five years experience in
24 business logistics, warehousing or storage appointed by the
25 Minority Leader of the Senate.

26 (8) An individual with at least five years experience in
27 business logistics, warehousing or storage appointed by the
28 Majority Leader of the House of Representatives.

29 (9) An individual with at least five years experience in
30 business logistics, warehousing or storage appointed by the
31 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.

32 (c) Duties.--

33 (1) Within one year of the effective date of this
34 section, the advisory board shall submit a plan for utilizing
35 an existing facility or constructing a new facility at Fort
36 Indiantown Gap for the ongoing storage of personal protective
37 equipment and other emergency resources needed for the
38 Commonwealth's response to the COVID-19 pandemic to all of

1 the following:

2 (i) The Governor.

3 (ii) The President pro tempore of the Senate.

4 (iii) The Majority Leader of the Senate.

5 (iv) The Minority Leader of the Senate.

6 (v) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.

7 (vi) The Majority Leader of the House of
8 Representatives.

9 (vii) The Minority Leader of the House of
10 Representatives.

11 (2) The plan under paragraph (1) shall:

12 (i) Outline the size and fit out required for the
13 facility.

14 (ii) Take into consideration the long-term usage of
15 the facility, including the ability of the facility to
16 respond to future natural disasters or pandemics.

17 (iii) Provide estimated costs to convert or
18 construct the facility.

19 (iv) Recommend Federal resources, State resources or
20 other resources available to design and construct the
21 facility.

22 (v) Provide a cost estimate and a timeline for any
23 proposed construction.

24 (vi) Outline anticipated obstacles to the immediate
25 completion or construction of the facility.

26 (vii) Highlight the unique capabilities available at
27 Fort Indiantown Gap to store the emergency management
28 resources of this Commonwealth.

29 (d) Expiration.--This section shall expire and the advisory
30 board shall cease to exist 30 days after submission of the
31 report issued under subsection (c). The Pennsylvania Emergency
32 Management Agency shall submit a notice of the expiration of
33 this section to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication
34 in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
