COVID-19 vaccine personal information privacy. 9 (a) General rule.--Except as provided in subsection (b), a 10 COVID-19 vaccine provider shall delete the personal information 11 12 of an individual who registered to receive a COVID-19 vaccine from the COVID-19 vaccine provider but did not receive the 13 COVID-19 vaccine within six months of the registration. In such 14 15 a circumstance, the deletion of the personal information shall 16 occur: 17 (1) Within 30 days after the conclusion of the six-month 18 period following the registration, if the conclusion of the 19 the six-month period occurs after the effective date of this 20 subsection. 21 (2) Within 30 days after the effective date of this 22 subsection, if the effective date of this subsection occurs 23 after the conclusion of the six-month period following the 24 registration. 25 (b) Exception.--In compliance with Federal and State law, a COVID-19 vaccine provider may retain the personal information of 26 an individual if the COVID-19 vaccine provider distributed or 27 28 administered a COVID-19 vaccine to the individual or provided 29 another health care service to the individual within six months of the individual registering to receive a COVID-19 vaccine from 30 31 the COVID-19 vaccine provider. 32 Section 5.
