

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1300

1 Amend Bill, page 87, line 1, by inserting after "1302.1(a)"  
2 and (a.3) (1) and (2)

3 Amend Bill, page 89, line 12, by striking out "second Monday"  
4 and inserting  
5 fifteenth day

6 Amend Bill, page 89, by inserting between lines 13 and 14

7 (a.3) (1) The following categories of electors may apply  
8 for an absentee ballot under this subsection, if otherwise  
9 qualified:

10 (i) An elector whose physical disability or illness  
11 prevented the elector from applying for an absentee ballot  
12 before five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day  
13 prior to the day of the primary or election.

14 (ii) An elector who, because of the elector's business,  
15 duties or occupation, was unable to apply for an absentee ballot  
16 before five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day  
17 prior to the day of the primary or election.

18 (iii) An elector who becomes so physically disabled or ill  
19 after five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day  
20 prior to the day of the primary or election that the elector is  
21 unable to appear at the polling place on the day of the primary  
22 or election.

23 (iv) An elector who, because of the conduct of the elector's  
24 business, duties or occupation, will necessarily be absent from  
25 the elector's municipality of residence on the day of the  
26 primary or election, which fact was not and could not reasonably  
27 be known to the elector on or before five o'clock P.M. on the  
28 [first Tuesday] fifteenth day prior to the day of the primary or  
29 election.

30 (2) An elector described in paragraph (1) may submit an  
31 application for an absentee ballot at any time up until the time  
32 of the closing of the polls on the day of the primary or  
33 election. The application shall include a declaration describing  
34 the circumstances that prevented the elector from applying for  
35 an absentee ballot before five o'clock P.M. on the [first

1 Tuesday] fifteenth day prior to the day of the primary or  
2 election or that prevent the elector from appearing at the  
3 polling place on the day of the primary or election, and the  
4 elector's qualifications under paragraph (1). The declaration  
5 shall be made subject to the provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904  
6 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

7 Amend Bill, page 96, line 18, by striking out the bracket  
8 before "no"

9 Amend Bill, page 96, line 19, by inserting a bracket before  
10 "seven"

11 Amend Bill, page 96, lines 19 through 21, by striking out "at  
12 least twice, including at nine" in line 19, all of line 20 and  
13 "first Saturday" in line 21 and inserting  
14 twenty-one (21) days

15 Amend Bill, page 104, line 23, by striking out "second  
16 Monday" and inserting  
17 fifteenth day
