1 Amend Bill, page 6, lines 13 through 15 (A01755), by striking
2 out all of said lines and inserting

3 Amend Bill, page 87, line 1, by inserting after "1302.1(a)"
4 and (a.3)(1) and (2)

5 Amend Bill, page 89, line 12, by striking out "second Monday"
6 and inserting
7 fifteenth day

8 Amend Bill, page 89, by inserting between lines 13 and 14
9 (a.3) (1) The following categories of electors may apply
10 for an absentee ballot under this subsection, if otherwise
11 qualified:

12 (i) An elector whose physical disability or illness
13 prevented the elector from applying for an absentee ballot
14 before five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day
15 prior to the day of the primary or election.

16 (ii) An elector who, because of the elector's business,
17 duties or occupation, was unable to apply for an absentee ballot
18 before five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day
19 prior to the day of the primary or election.

20 (iii) An elector who becomes so physically disabled or ill
21 after five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day
22 prior to the day of the primary or election that the elector is
23 unable to appear at the polling place on the day of the primary
24 or election.

25 (iv) An elector who, because of the conduct of the elector's
26 business, duties or occupation, will necessarily be absent from
27 the elector's municipality of residence on the day of the
28 primary or election, which fact was not and could not reasonably
29 be known to the elector on or before five o'clock P.M. on the
30 [first Tuesday] fifteenth day prior to the day of the primary or
31 election.

32 (2) An elector described in paragraph (1) may submit an
33 application for an absentee ballot at any time up until the time
34 of the closing of the polls on the day of the primary or
35 election. The application shall include a declaration describing
36 the circumstances that prevented the elector from applying for
37 an absentee ballot before five o'clock P.M. on the [first
38 Tuesday] fifteenth day prior to the day of the primary or

1 election or that prevent the elector from appearing at the
2 polling place on the day of the primary or election, and the
3 elector's qualifications under paragraph (1). The declaration
4 shall be made subject to the provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904
5 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

7 out all of said lines and inserting

8 Amend Bill, page 96, line 18, by striking out the bracket
9 before "no"

10 Amend Bill, page 96, line 19, by inserting a bracket before
11 "seven"

12 Amend Bill, page 96, lines 19 through 21, by striking out "at
13 least twice, including at nine" in line 19, all of line 20 and
14 "first Saturday" in line 21 and inserting
15 twenty-one (21) days

16 Amend Bill, page 8, lines 7 through 9 (A01755), by striking
17 out all of said lines and inserting
