- (2) An elector described in paragraph (1) may submit an application for an absentee ballot at any time up until the time 34 of the closing of the polls on the day of the primary or election. The application shall include a declaration describing the circumstances that prevented the elector from applying for an absentee ballot before five o'clock P.M. on the [first Tuesday] fifteenth day prior to the day of the primary or
