1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 1, by inserting after "testing;"
2 establishing the COVID-19 At-Home Testing Distribution Program;
3 Amend Bill, page 1, by inserting between lines 11 and 12
4 "County." The term includes a city of the first class.
5 Amend Bill, page 1, by inserting between lines 13 and 14
6 "COVID-19 at-home tests." Materials or devices for detecting
7 COVID-19 infection which has received Food and Drug
8 Administration Emergency Use Authorization for self-testing
9 without the need to ship samples to a lab or for a prescription
10 from a health care provider.
11 Amend Bill, page 1, by inserting between lines 14 and 15
12 "Program." The COVID-19 At-Home Testing Distribution Program
13 established under section 4.
14 Amend Bill, page 2, by inserting between lines 25 and 26
15 Section 4. COVID-19 At-Home Testing Distribution Program.
16 (a) Establishment.--The COVID-19 At-Home Testing
17 Distribution Program is established within the department.
18 (b) Acquisition of COVID-19 at-home tests.--The department
19 shall acquire COVID-19 at-home tests for distribution to
20 counties under this section.
21 (c) Application.--No later than 30 days after the effective
22 date of this section, the department shall receive applications
23 from counties for COVID-19 at-home tests. An application by a
24 county under this subsection shall include the number of COVID-
25 19 at-home tests requested and a proposed distribution plan.
26 (d) Review and approval.--No later than 45 days after the
27 effective date of this section, the department shall review and
28 approve applications under subsection (c).
29 (e) Distribution to counties.--The department shall begin
30 distributing COVID-19 at-home tests to approved counties no
31 later than 60 days after the effective date of this section.
32 (f) Distribution by counties.--A county which receives
33 COVID-19 at-home tests under this section may distribute the
34 tests to individuals in the county at publicly accessible mobile

1 testing sites and nontraditional testing sites, including county
2 buildings, municipal buildings, libraries, community centers,
3 police stations and fire stations. A county shall publicize the
4 distribution locations.

5 (g) Prohibition.--An individual that receives a COVID-19 at-
6 home test from a county under this section may not resell the
7 test.

8 (h) Use of funds.--The department shall use no less than
9 \$10,000,000 of money available to the department for the purpose
10 of the program, including money from the Federal Government
11 available from an appropriation for COVID - Epidemiology and
12 Laboratory Surveillance and Response.
