9 Section 1. Short title.

10 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Heavy-Duty
11 Diesel Emissions Control Program Suspension Procedures Act.
12 Section 2. Suspension of program.

13 The suspension of enforcement of the provisions of 25 Pa.
14 Code Ch. 126 Subch. E (relating to Pennsylvania Heavy-Duty
15 Diesel Emissions Control Program) by the Department of
16 Environmental Protection published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin
17 on November 6, 2021, is effective through and including model
18 year 2024 vehicles.

19 Section 3. Suspension expiration.

20 The suspension of enforcement by the Department of
21 Environmental Protection of any provision of 25 Pa. Code Ch. 126
22 Subch. E (relating to Pennsylvania Heavy-Duty Diesel Emissions
23 Control Program) shall expire as it relates to heavy-duty diesel
24 vehicles and engines beginning with model year 2025.

25 Section 4. Applicability of Federal standards.

26 During the effective period of a suspension of enforcement of
27 the provisions of 25 Pa. Code Ch. 126 Subch. E (relating to
28 Pennsylvania Heavy-Duty Diesel Emissions Control Program), the
29 Federal standards for heavy-duty diesel vehicles and engines
30 shall apply in this Commonwealth. While Federal standards are in
31 effect in the Commonwealth, a person in compliance with Federal
32 standards shall not be liable to suits based on 25 Pa. Code Ch.
33 126 Subch. E.

34 Section 5. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect immediately.
