16 Section 2012-L. Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
17 report.

18 The Legislative Budget and Finance Committee shall prepare
19 and submit to the General Assembly a report on the progress of
20 the program. The report shall include the number of applications
21 received for the program, the number of applications approved
22 for the program, the number of lifeline scholarship accounts
23 terminated early, the number of lifeline scholarship accounts
24 investigated for fraud, the number of prosecutions from the
25 investigations and other pertinent information the Legislative
26 Budget and Finance Committee deems helpful for the General
27 Assembly and the department. The report shall be submitted two
28 years after the first lifeline scholarship account is
29 established.
