

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 2169

1 Amend Bill, page 13, line 14, by striking out "Hardware," and  
2 inserting

3 Computer hardware and

4 Amend Bill, page 13, line 16, by inserting after  
5 "subsection."

6 Computer hardware associated with the eligible student  
7 shall comply with subsection (b).

8 Amend Bill, page 13, by inserting between lines 24 and 25

9 (b) Computer hardware specifications.--

10 (1) Computer hardware purchased under subsection (a) (5)  
11 must contain filters installed by a public school or  
12 nonpublic school in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).

13 (2) The Department of Education shall establish  
14 guidelines for filters to prevent computer hardware purchased  
15 under subsection (a) (5) from being used to access  
16 pornography, gambling sites and social media on the Internet.

17 (3) Computer hardware purchased under subsection (a) (5)  
18 must be purchased from a public school or nonpublic school  
19 with filters that comply with paragraph (2) and that are in  
20 compliance with the Internet safety policy adopted and  
21 implemented under section 254(h) (5) of the Children's  
22 Internet Protection Act (Public Law 106-554, 47 U.S.C. §  
23 254(h) (5)) and acceptable-use policy under section 4 of the  
24 act of November 30, 2004 (P.L.1556, No.197), known as the  
25 Child Internet Protection Act, or any other software or  
26 technology protection measures that block or filter access to  
27 inappropriate matter by minors on the resident school  
28 district's computers. The resident school district may impose  
29 and collect from the parent or eligible student a fee for the  
30 cost of installing the filters.

31 (4) Prior to use of the computer hardware purchased  
32 under subsection (a) (5), the parent and eligible student  
33 shall sign and provide the public school or nonpublic school  
34 with a notarized affidavit stating that they will not remove  
35 or attempt to remove the filters from the computer hardware

1 and understand that the removing or attempting to remove the  
2 filters shall constitute fraudulent misuse of the lifeline  
3 scholarship account and result in termination of the  
4 agreement by the department under section 2003-L(f)(2) and  
5 the penalties imposed under the agreement and this act.
