- completed under 67 Pa.C.S. Chs. 71 and 73. Orders,
- regulations, rules and decisions which were made under the
- 31 Resource Family and Adoption Process Act and the Resource
- 32 Family Care Act and which are in effect on the effective date
- of this section shall remain in full force and effect until
- revoked, vacated or modified under 67 Pa.C.S. Chs. 71 and 73.
- 35 Contracts, obligations and collective bargaining agreements
- 36 entered into under the Resource Family and Adoption Process
- 37 Act and the Resource Family Care Act are not affected nor
- impaired by the repeal of the Resource Family and Adoption

1 Process Act and the Resource Family Care Act.

(2) Any difference in language between 67 Pa.C.S. Chs. 71 and 73 and the Resource Family and Adoption Process Act and the Resource Family Care Act is intended only to conform to the style of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes and is not intended to change or affect the legislative intent, judicial construction or administration and implementation of the Resource Family and Adoption Process Act and the Resource Family Care Act.
