26 occurs at least three months after the proposed  
27 constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly.

28 (2) Submit the proposed constitutional amendment under  
29 section 1(2) of this resolution to the qualified electors of  
30 this Commonwealth as a separate ballot question at the first  
31 primary, general or municipal election which meets the  
32 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of  
33 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which  
34 occurs at least three months after the proposed  
35 constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly.
