14 15 § 15. Election audits. The General Assembly shall by statute provide for the 16

auditing of elections, including the administration of 17

18 elections, certification of election machines, the accuracy of the list of registered voters, the administration of voter 19

registration and election results. Election audits shall be 20

conducted by the Auditor General. In years when the Auditor 21

General stands for election to any office, an Independent 22

23 Auditor shall conduct the audit.

Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 24 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the 25 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 26 27 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 28 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 29 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 30 31 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments. 32 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these

proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the 33

Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of these proposed constitutional amendments. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall:

8 Submit the proposed constitutional amendment under (1)9 section 1(1) of this resolution to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth as a separate ballot question at the first 10 11 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 12 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of 13 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which 14 occurs at least three months after the proposed 15 constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly.

16 (2) Submit the proposed constitutional amendment under 17 section 1(2) of this resolution to the qualified electors of 18 this Commonwealth as a separate ballot question at the first 19 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 20 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of 21 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which 22 occurs at least three months after the proposed 23 constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly.
