

AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 106

1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 1, by striking out "an amendment"
2 and inserting

3 separate and distinct amendments

4 Amend Bill, page 1, line 2, by inserting after "Governor"
5 and providing for election audits

6 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 5 and 6, by striking out all of
7 said lines and inserting

8 Section 1. The following separate and distinct amendments to
9 the Constitution of Pennsylvania are proposed in accordance with
10 Article XI:

11 (1)

12 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 8 through 30, by striking out all
13 of said lines and inserting

14 (2) That Article VII be amended by adding a section to read:
15 § 15. Election audits.

16 The General Assembly shall by statute provide for the
17 auditing of elections, including the administration of
18 elections, certification of election machines, the accuracy of
19 the list of registered voters, the administration of voter
20 registration and election results. Election audits shall be
21 conducted by the Auditor General. In years when the Auditor
22 General stands for election to any office, an Independent
23 Auditor shall conduct the audit.

24 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
25 Assembly of these proposed constitutional amendments, the
26 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
27 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
28 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
29 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
30 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
31 passage of these proposed constitutional amendments.

32 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of these
33 proposed constitutional amendments, the Secretary of the

1 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
2 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
3 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
4 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
5 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
6 these proposed constitutional amendments. The Secretary of the
7 Commonwealth shall:

8 (1) Submit the proposed constitutional amendment under
9 section 1(1) of this resolution to the qualified electors of
10 this Commonwealth as a separate ballot question at the first
11 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
12 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of
13 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which
14 occurs at least three months after the proposed
15 constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly.

16 (2) Submit the proposed constitutional amendment under
17 section 1(2) of this resolution to the qualified electors of
18 this Commonwealth as a separate ballot question at the first
19 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
20 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of
21 Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which
22 occurs at least three months after the proposed
23 constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly.
