- at least equal to the real property tax collected by the school 21
- 22 district on homesteads and farmsteads during the fiscal year
- ending June 30, 2026, less the annual debt service legally 23
- obligated to be paid by the school district during the fiscal 24
- 25 year ending June 30, 2026. The maintenance and support of school districts may include, but need not be limited to: 26
- 27 (1) A State tax on each separate sale at retail of tangible personal property or services in this Commonwealth. 28

- (c) Under no circumstances may the General Assembly provide, 34
- by general, local or special law, for a real property tax on a 35

- 2 (d) Except for taxes imposed under subsection (b) (3) and
- 3 (4), all proceeds from other taxes imposed under subsection (b),
- 4 shall be deposited into a separate fund in the State Treasury,
