14 Article XXIII-A of the act of May, 17 1921 (P.L.682, No.284),  
15 known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921.

16 "Health insurance policy." A policy, subscriber contract,  
17 certificate or plan issued by an insurer that provides hospital  
18 or medical/surgical health care coverage. The term does not  
19 include any of the following:

20 (1) An accident-only policy.

21 (2) A credit-only policy.

22 (3) A long-term care or disability income policy.

23 (4) A specified disease policy.

24 (5) A Medicare supplement policy.

25 (6) A fixed indemnity policy.

26 (7) A dental-only policy.

27 (8) A vision-only policy

28 (9) A workers' compensation policy.

29 (10) An automobile medical payment policy.

30 (11) A policy under which benefits are provided by the  
31 Federal Government to active or former military personnel and  
32 their dependents.

33 (12) A hospital indemnity policy.

1           (13) Any other similar policy providing for limited  
2           benefits.  
3           "Insurer." An entity that offers, issues or renews an  
4 individual or group health, accident or sickness insurance  
5 policy, contract or plan and that is subject to any of the  
6 following:  
7           (1) 40 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to hospital plan  
8           corporations) or 63 (relating to professional health services  
9           plan corporations).  
10          (2) The Insurance Company Law of 1921, including section  
11          630 and Article XXIV.  
12          (3) The act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701, No.364),  
13          known as the Health Maintenance Organization Act.
