1 Amend Bill, page 1, by inserting between lines 13 and 14

2 5903. COVID-19 vaccine information on identification cards  
3 prohibited.

4 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 12 and 13

5 § 5903. COVID-19 vaccine information on identification cards  
6 prohibited.

7 A government entity or political subdivision may not do any  
8 of the following:

9 (1) Include information on an identification card or  
10 electronic tracking system regarding whether the holder of  
11 the identification card has received a vaccination against  
12 COVID-19.

13 (2) Expend funds to develop an electronic tracking  
14 system for an individual who has or has not received a  
15 vaccination against COVID-19.

16 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 18 through 29, by striking out all  
17 of said lines and inserting

18 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including the act  
19 of April 23, 1956 (1955 P.L.1510, No.500), known as the Disease  
20 Prevention and Control Law of 1955, the Secretary of Health may  
21 not do any of the following:

22 (1) Order or otherwise require a closure.

23 (2) Order or otherwise require an individual that has  
24 not been exposed or potentially exposed to a contagious  
25 disease to do any of the following:

26 (i) Physically distance from other individuals.

27 (ii) Wear a universal face covering.

28 (iii) Conduct a specific hygienic practice.

29 (iv) Shelter in place, quarantine or isolate from  
30 other individuals.

31 (v) Restrict travel.
