- (c) Adoption of Federal statute, regulation, standard or criteria. -- The department shall be authorized to adopt by reference any Federal statute, regulation, standard or criteria or provision thereof relating to vehicles or drivers, including, but not limited to, minimum driver qualifications, maximum hours of service, loading, unloading, hazardous materials, operation, equipment, records and inspection.
  - (1) The department shall be authorized to extend the coverage of any Federal statute, regulation, standard or criteria adopted under this subsection to vehicles and drivers operating only in intrastate commerce, except as follows:
    - No Federal statute, regulation, standard or criteria shall be extended to cover farm tractors or drivers of farm tractors, regardless of whether the farm tractor is operated as a combination.
    - (iv) No Federal statute, regulation, standard or criteria shall be extended to cover implements of husbandry other than farm tractors, farm vehicles or drivers of these vehicles, regardless of whether the vehicle is operated as a combination, provided that:
      - (A) the vehicle's or combination's gross weight, gross vehicle weight rating or gross combination weight rating does not equal or exceed 26,001 pounds;
      - (B) the vehicle or combination is not carrying hazardous materials in an amount that requires the towing or towed vehicle to be placarded under Chapter 83 (relating to hazardous materials transportation);

1 and (C) the vehicle or combination is not designed 2 3 or used to transport 16 or more people, including the 4 driver. 5 For purposes of [this paragraph] <u>subparagraphs</u> (iii) and (iv), the term "farm tractors" includes 6 7 tractors designed for off-road agricultural use, 8 combines, crop pickers, crop and forage harvesters, 9 threshers, plows, tillers, planters, seeders, field sprayers, forage cutters, balers and similar vehicles 10 11 that are infrequently operated or moved upon highways and 12 that are used by a farmer in agricultural production. 13 (vi) No Federal statute, regulation, standard or criteria shall be extended to cover a motor vehicle 14 15 transporting property along a highway in this Commonwealth, regardless of whether the motor vehicle is 16 operated as a combination, provided that all of the 17 18 following criteria are met: 19 (A) the vehicle's or combination's gross weight, 20 gross vehicle weight rating or gross combination weight rating does not equal or exceed 26,001 pounds; 21 (B) the vehicle or combination is not carrying 22 23 hazardous materials in an amount that requires the towing or towed vehicle to be placarded under Chapter 24 25 83; 26 (C) the vehicle or combination is not designed or used to transport 16 or more people, including the 27 28 driver; and 29 (D) the motor vehicle or combination is being 30 used to transport property, including a vehicle, to 31 or from an amateur competitive event, regardless of 32 whether the motor vehicle or combination owner is 33 sponsored for participation in the amateur 34 competitive event. 35 36 (f) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term "amateur competitive event" shall mean a competition, tournament or 37 38 athletic event, including motorsports, where the competitors' participation is not the result of an employment contract that 39 requires participation in the competitive event, notwithstanding 40 the receipt of prize money or sponsorship. 41
