28 Section 2. The addition of section 635.8 of the act shall
29 apply to the following:

30 (1) For a health insurance policy for which either rates
31 or forms are required to be filed with the Insurance
32 Department or the Federal Government, a policy for which a
33 form or rate is first filed on or after the effective date of
34 this section.

35 (2) For a health insurance policy for which rates or
36 forms are not required to be filed with the Insurance
37 Department or the Federal Government, a policy issued or
38 renewed on or after 180 days from the effective date of this
39 section.

1 (3) A contract between a health care practitioner and an
2 insurer that is executed or renewed on or after 180 days from
3 the effective date of this section.
