5 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 6 and 7

6 Nothing in this subsection shall be construed as to preclude  
7 utilization review as provided under Article XXI of this act or  
8 to prevent the application of deductible, copayment or  
9 coinsurance provisions contained in the policy or plan for  
10 breast imaging in excess of the minimum coverage required.

11 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 7 and 8

12 (d) As used in this section:  
13 "Supplemental breast screening" means a medically necessary  
14 and clinically appropriate examination of the breast using  
15 either standard or abbreviated magnetic resonance imaging or, if  
16 such imaging is not possible, ultrasound if recommended by the  
17 treating physician to screen for breast cancer when there is no  
18 abnormality seen or suspected in the breast.
