

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 181

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1 Amend Bill, page 24, by inserting between lines 15 and 16

2 (2) If benefits under this act are paid as the result of
3 a circumstance that is the fault of a recipient, the
4 recipient shall be liable to repay a sum equal to the amount
5 of benefits received as the result of that circumstance and
6 interest at the rate determined by the Secretary of Revenue
7 in accordance with section 806 of the act of April 9, 1929
8 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, per month or
9 fraction of a month, from 15 days after notice of the
10 overpayment was issued until the sum and any interest are
11 repaid.

15 Amend Bill, page 24, line 19, by inserting after "and"

16 interest at the rate determined by the Secretary of

27 all of lines 27 and 28 and "PENALTY IN THE" in line 29 and

29 in the case of willful misrepresentation, the employee:
30 (i) Shall be required to pay a penalty in the

5 sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$500 nor

8 (B) Each false statement, misrepresentation or
9 failure to disclose a material fact shall constitute
10 a separate offense.

11 (5) The department may collect money owed under
12 paragraph (2), (3) or (4) in the manner provided in section
13 308.1 of the Unemployment Compensation Law, for the
14 collection of past due contributions.
