26 Pa.C.S. § 6505 (relating to power to confer degrees) and to

27 apply itself the designation "college" or "university" as

28 provided for by the standards and qualifications prescribed by

29 the State Board of Education under 24 Pa.C.S. Ch. 65 (relating

30 to private colleges, universities and seminaries).

21 (e) Administrative costs.--From funds appropriated to the  
22 agency for the program, the agency may retain a reasonable  
23 amount necessary to pay for direct costs to implement the  
24 program, not to exceed 5%. The agency shall include an estimate  
25 of costs to administer the program within its annual submissions  
26 under section 610 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175),  
27 known as The Administrative Code of 1929.
