1 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 11 through 27, by striking out all
2 of said lines and inserting

3 (i) A criminal act, with bodily injury or serious
4 bodily injury inflicted upon the victim, as defined under
5 any of the following:

6 (A) section 2701(a)(1) or (3) (relating to
7 simple assault).

8 (B) section 2702 (relating to aggravated
9 assault).

10 (C) section 2703 (relating to assault by
11 prisoner).

12 (D) section 2703.1 (relating to aggravated
13 harassment by prisoner).

14 (E) section 2707 (relating to propulsion of
15 missiles into an occupied vehicle or onto a roadway).

16 (F) section 2707.1 (relating to discharge of a
17 firearm into an occupied structure).

18 (G) section 2713 (relating to neglect of care-
19 dependent person).

20 (H) section 2718 (relating to strangulation).

21 (ii) If the conduct is intentional or reckless, a
22 criminal act causing damage to property under any of the
23 following:

24 (A) section 3301 (relating to arson and related
25 offenses).

26 (B) section 3302 (relating to causing or risking
27 catastrophe).

28 (C) section 3304 (relating to criminal
29 mischieff).

30 (iii) A criminal act under section 3503(a), (b) or
31 (b.1) (relating to criminal trespass).

32 (2) The person intentionally selected the victim against
33 whom the offense under paragraph (1) was committed or the
34 victim's property that was damaged or otherwise affected, in
35 whole or in substantial part, because of the victim's actual
36 or perceived:

37 (i) race;

38 (ii) color;

1 (iii) religion;
2 (iv) national origin;
3 (v) ethnicity;
4 (vi) ancestry;
5 (vii) age;
6 (viii) sex;
7 (ix) gender;
8 (x) gender identity;
9 (xi) gender expression;
10 (xii) sexual orientation;
11 (xiii) status as a former or current peace officer;
12 or
13 (xiv) physical disability, intellectual disability
14 or autism spectrum disorder reasonably obvious to the
15 person.

18 Amend Bill, page 3, line 5, by inserting a bracket before
19 "Definition.--As"

20 Amend Bill, page 3, line 10, by inserting after
21 "individuals.]"

22 As used in this section, the following words and phrases
23 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
24 the context clearly indicates otherwise:

25 "Autism spectrum disorder." As defined in 42 Pa.C.S. § 5992
26 (relating to definitions).

27 "Intellectual disability." Regardless of the age of the
28 individual, significantly subaverage general intellectual
29 functioning of an individual that is accompanied by significant
30 limitations in adaptive functioning in at least two of the
31 following skill areas:

- 32 (1) Communication.
- 33 (2) Self-care.
- 34 (3) Home living.
- 35 (4) Social and interpersonal.
- 36 (5) Use of community resources.
- 37 (6) Self-direction.
- 38 (7) Functional academic.
- 39 (8) Work.
- 40 (9) Health and safety.

41 "Peace officer." As defined in section 501 (relating to
42 definitions).

43 "Physical disability." A permanent or irreversible physical
44 impairment, whether congenital or acquired by accident, injury
45 or disease, that substantially limits one or more major life

1 activities of the individual.
