26 League or a designee.

27 (14) The Executive Director for the Pennsylvania State
28 Association of Township Supervisors or a designee.

29 (15) The Executive Director for the Pennsylvania State
30 Association of Boroughs or a designee.

31 (16) The Executive Director for the Pennsylvania State
32 Association of Township Commissioners or a designee.

33 (c) The Cybersecurity Coordination Board shall also include
34 three cybersecurity experts that shall be appointed by and serve
35 at the pleasure of the Governor. The cybersecurity experts must
36 have professional experience in cybersecurity or information
37 technology.

1 (d) If a member of the Cybersecurity Coordination Board
2 sends a designee in the member's place, the designee must have a
3 background in cybersecurity or be the cybersecurity expert of
4 the designating board member.
