19 (2) Upon the drafting of a preliminary model municipal 20 ordinance under paragraph (1), the department shall transmit 21 a copy of the preliminary model municipal ordinance to the 22 Senate and the House of Representatives.

23 (3) Upon the adoption of a resolution approving the 24 preliminary model municipal ordinance by the Senate and the 25 House of Representatives, the department shall transmit 26 notice that the preliminary model municipal ordinance has 27 been adopted as a final model municipal ordinance to the 28 Legislative Reference Bureau.

29 (4) Upon receipt of a notice under paragraph (3), the 30 Legislative Reference Bureau shall publish the final model 31 municipal ordinance in the next available issue of the 32 Pennsylvania Bulletin.
