- 30 (i) Five dollars sixty-five cents (\$5.65) an hour beginning 31 January 1, 2007.
- 32 Six dollars sixty-five cents (\$6.65) an hour beginning 33 July 1, 2007.

1 (2) Such employer shall pay the full amount of the minimum 2 wage under section 4(a)(8) beginning July 1, 2008.]
