1 Amend Bill, page 2, line 1, by striking out "a subsection"

2 and inserting

3 subsections

4 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 4 through 9, by striking out all of
5 said lines and inserting

6 F. Notwithstanding any other law, an employee employed by a
7 licensee licensed under the act of April 8, 1937 (P.L.262,
8 No.66), known as the "Consumer Discount Company Act," may work
9 from a remote location if all of the following requirements are
10 met:

11 (1) The licensed activities are conducted under the
12 supervision of the licensee.

13 (2) The licensee has written policies and procedures for the
14 supervision of employees working from the remote location.

15 (3) Access to the licensee's platforms and customer
16 information is conducted in accordance with the licensee's
17 comprehensive written information security plan.

18 (4) In-person consumer interaction does not occur at the
19 remote location if the remote location is at the employee's
20 personal residence.

21 (5) The remote location is not advertised or represented to
22 consumers as an operating location of the licensee or the
23 licensee's employees who work at the remote location.

24 (6) The remote location is not owned or controlled by the
25 licensee. A remote location shall not be considered owned or
26 controlled by a licensee if the remote location is under the
27 control of a subsidiary or affiliate of the licensee, is
28 primarily used by the subsidiary or affiliate and is only used
29 by the licensee on an incidental basis for the convenience of
30 consumers.

31 G. Notwithstanding any other law, an employee employed by a
32 licensee licensed under 12 Pa.C.S. Ch. 62 (relating to motor
33 vehicle sales finance) may work from a remote location if all of
34 the following requirements are met:

35 (1) The licensed activities are conducted under the
36 supervision of the licensee.

1 (2) The licensee has written policies and procedures for the
2 supervision of employees working from the remote location.

3 (3) Access to the licensee's platforms and customer
4 information is conducted in accordance with the licensee's
5 comprehensive written information security plan.

6 (4) In-person consumer interaction does not occur at the

9 (5) The remote location is not advertised or represented to
