

AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1661

Sponsor: SENATOR VOGEL

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1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 10 through 12, by striking out
2 "further providing for" in line 10 and all of lines 11 and 12
3 and inserting

4 further providing for schedules of controlled substances; and
5 providing for secure storage of xylazine.

6 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 15 through 22; pages 2 through 4,
7 lines 1 through 30; page 5, lines 1 through 14; by striking out
8 all of said lines on said pages and inserting

9 Section 1. Section 4(3) of the act of April 14, 1972
10 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug,
11 Device and Cosmetic Act, is amended by adding subclauses to
12 read:

13 Section 4. Schedules of Controlled Substances.--The
14 following schedules include the controlled substances listed or
15 to be listed by whatever official name, common or usual name,
16 chemical name, or trade name designated.

17 * * *

18 (3) Schedule III--In determining that a substance comes
19 within this schedule, the secretary shall find: a potential for
20 abuse less than the substances listed in Schedules I and II;
21 well documented and currently accepted medical use in the United
22 States; and abuse may lead to moderate or low physical
23 dependence or high psychological dependence. The following
24 classes of controlled substances are included in this schedule:

26 (x) Xylazine, including any of the following substances,
27 their salts, isomers and salts of isomers whenever the existence
28 of the salts, isomers and salts of isomers is possible within
29 the specific chemical designation:

- 30 1. Xylazine.
- 31 2. Xylazine-M (2,6-Mich dimethylaniline).
- 32 3. Xylazine-M (N-thiourea-2,6-dimethylaniline).
- 33 4. Xylazine-M (Sulfone-HO-) isomer 2.
- 34 5. Xylazine-M (HO-2,6-dimethylaline isomer 1).

- 1 6. Xylazine-M (HO-2,6-dimethylalaine isomer 2).
2 7. Xylazine M (oxo-).
3 8. Xylazine-M (HO-) isomer 1.
4 9. Xylazine-M (HO-) isomer 1 glucuronide.
5 10. Xylazine-M (HO-) isomer 2.
6 11. Xylazine-M (HO-) isomer 2 glucuronide.
7 12. Xylazine-M (HO-oxo-) isomer 1.
8 13. Xylazine-M (HO-oxo-) isomer 1 glucuronide.
9 14. Xylazine-M (HO-oxo-) isomer 2.
10 15. Xylazine-M (HO-oxo-) isomer 2 glucuronide.
11 16. Xylazine-M (sulfone).
12 17. Xylazine-M (sulfone-HO-) isomer 1.
13 18. A compound, mixture or preparation which contains any
14 quantity of the substances referred to in this clause.
15 (xi) Xylazine as described in subclass (x) is not a
16 controlled substance when used in any of the following manners:
17 1. Dispensing or prescribing for, or administering to, a
18 nonhuman species of a drug containing xylazine that:
19 (A) has been approved by the United States Secretary of
20 Health and Human Services under 21 U.S.C. § 360b (relating to
21 new animal drugs); or
22 (B) is authorized under 21 U.S.C. § 360b(a)(4).
23 2. The manufacturing, distribution or use of xylazine as an
24 active pharmaceutical ingredient for manufacturing an animal
25 drug approved under 21 U.S.C. § 360b or an animal drug that has
26 been issued an investigation use exemption under 21 U.S.C. §
27 360b(j).
28 3. The manufacturing, distribution or use of a xylazine bulk
29 chemical for pharmaceutical compounding by a licensed pharmacist
30 or veterinarians.
31 4. Any other use approved or authorized under 21 U.S.C. Ch.
32 9 (relating to Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act).
33 5. Another use approved or permissible under Federal or
34 State law.
