1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 3, by striking out "and" and  
2 inserting a comma

3 Amend Bill, page 1, line 4, by striking out the period after  
4 "veterans" and inserting  
5 , for special plates for recipients of Soldier's Medal, for  
6 special plates for recipients of Presidential Service Badge,  
7 for special plates for recipients of Legion of Merit and for  
8 special plates for veterans of an ally foreign country.

11 Section 1. Sections 1361, 1364, 1368.1, 1368.2, 1368.3 and  
12 1369.3 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are

15 § 1368.1. Special plates for recipients of Soldier's Medal.

16 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the  
17 Soldier's Medal, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$26 which shall  
18 be in addition to the registration fee and by such documentation  
19 as the department shall require, the department shall issue to  
20 the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle  
21 so licensed as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the  
22 Soldier's Medal. The special registration plate may be used only  
23 on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of  
24 not more than 14,000 pounds.

25 § 1368.2. Special plates for recipients of Presidential Service  
26 Badge.

27 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the  
28 Presidential Service Badge, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$26  
29 which shall be in addition to the registration fee and by such  
30 documentation as the department shall require, the department  
31 shall issue to the person a special registration plate  
32 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who  
33 is a recipient of the Presidential Service Badge. The special

1 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck  
2 with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

3 § 1368.3. Special plates for recipients of Legion of Merit.

4       Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the  
5 Legion of Merit, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$26 which shall  
6 be in addition to the registration fee and any documentation the  
7 department requires, the department shall issue to the person a  
8 special registration plate designating the vehicle licensed as  
9 belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Legion of Merit.  
10 The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger  
11 car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than  
12 14,000 pounds.

13 § 1369.3. Special plates for veterans of an ally foreign  
14           country.

15       Upon application of a person who was a citizen of a foreign  
16 country that allied with the United States in a military  
17 conflict and served in a military branch of that foreign country  
18 during the military conflict, accompanied by a fee of [\$20] \$26  
19 which shall be in addition to the registration fee and by such  
20 documentation as the department shall require, the department  
21 shall issue to the person a special registration plate  
22 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who  
23 is a veteran of a military branch of a foreign country that  
24 allied with the United States in a military conflict. The  
25 special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car  
26 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000  
27 pounds.
