12 (b) Solar energy projects. -- Any contractor, subcontractor or worker performing construction, reconstruction, demolition, 13 14 repair or maintenance work on a solar energy project funded 15 under this act shall meet all of the following requirements:

16 (1) Maintain all valid licenses, registrations or 17 certificates required by the Federal Government, the 18 Commonwealth or a local government entity that is necessary 19 to do business or perform applicable work.

20 (2) Maintain compliance with the act of June 2, 1915 21 (P.L.736, No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, 22 the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, 23 No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, and 24 bonding and liability insurance requirements as specified in 25 the contract for the solar energy project.

26 (3) Has not defaulted on a project, declared bankruptcy, 27 been debarred or suspended on a project by the Federal 28 Government, the Commonwealth or a local government entity 29 within the previous three years.

30 (4) Has not been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony 31 relating to the performance or operation of the business of 32 the contractor or subcontractor within the previous 10 years. 1 (5) Has completed a minimum of the United States 2 Occupational Safety and Health Administration's 10-hour 3 safety training course or similar training sufficient to 4 prepare workers for any hazards that may be encountered 5 during their work.

6 (c) Violations.--The Department of Labor and Industry shall
7 enforce this section in accordance with the laws of this
8 Commonwealth. The Department of Labor and Industry shall apply
