1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 10 through 18; page 2, lines 1
2 through 3; by striking out all of said lines on said pages and
3 inserting

4 (f.1) Violation of title or local ordinance.--An owner or
5 operator of a tow truck that recovers or removes a wrecked or
6 disabled vehicle from the roadway to the nearest safe refuge on
7 the shoulder, emergency lane or median at the direction of a
8 police officer, while the police officer is engaged in the
9 performance of the police officer's official duties, shall not
10 be convicted of a violation of the provisions of section 3308
11 (relating to one-way roadways and rotary traffic islands),
12 Subchapter E of Chapter 33 (relating to stopping, standing and
13 parking), Chapter 49 (relating to size, weight and load) or a
14 similar ordinance of a local authority for an action performed
15 by the owner or operator of the tow truck during the recovery or
16 removal of the wrecked or disabled vehicle if the action was
17 performed at the specific direction of the police officer while
18 the police officer is engaged in the performance of the police
19 officer's official duties. This section does not relieve the
20 owner or operator of a tow truck from the duty to drive with due
21 regard for the safety of all persons.
