31 § 3301. Scope of chapter.

32 This chapter relates to the administration of the
33 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program in this Commonwealth.

34 § 3302. Definitions.

35 "SNAP." The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
36 established under 7 U.S.C. Ch. 51 (relating to Supplemental
37 Nutrition Assistance Program) and administered by the Department
38 of Human Services.

39 § 3303. Administration of SNAP.

40 In addition to duties under the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
41 No.21), known as the Human Services Code, the department shall:

42 (1) (i) Request a waiver to the Commonwealth's plan of
43 operation under 7 CFR Subt. B Ch. II Subch. C (relating
44 to Supplemental Nutrition Assistance and Food
45 Distribution Program) to authorize the department to
46 place a limit on the amount of federally funded SNAP
47 benefits that may be accumulated in a recipient's
48 account. Subject to Federal approval, the department

1 shall limit the amount of federally funded benefits that
2 may be accumulated by a recipient to no more than 12
3 months of the recipient's allotment and shall recover any
4 money over the limit amount.

5 (ii) Place a limit on the amount of benefits under 3
6 Pa.C.S. Ch. 110 (relating to Pennsylvania Food Bucks
7 Program) that may be accumulated in a recipient's
8 account. The department shall limit the amount of
9 federally funded benefits that may be accumulated by a
10 recipient to no more than three months of the recipient's
11 allotment under 3 Pa.C.S. Ch. 110 and shall recover any
12 money over the limit amount.
