21 (c) Grading.--

22 (1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2), the
23 following apply:

24 (i) An offense under this section constitutes a
25 misdemeanor of the second degree.

26 (ii) If the aggregate amount of money or other thing
27 of value involved is less than \$10,000, the offense

1 constitutes a misdemeanor of the first degree.

2 (iii) If the aggregate amount of money or other
3 thing of value involved is \$10,000 or more but less than
4 \$100,000, the offense constitutes a felony of the third
5 degree.

6 (iv) If the aggregate amount of money or other thing
7 of value involved is \$100,000 or more but less than
8 \$500,000, the offense constitutes a felony of the second
9 degree.

10 (v) If the aggregate amount of money or other thing
11 of value involved is at least \$500,000, the offense
12 constitutes a felony of the first degree.

13 (2) The grading of an offense under subsection (a)(1),
14 (2) or (3) shall be increased one degree if the commission of
15 the offense:

16 (i) is a second or subsequent offense;

17 (ii) involves the infliction of a physical injury;

18 or

19 (iii) involves a computer, computer system or
20 computer network, or any data held by the computer,
21 computer system or computer network, of a court or agency
22 of the unified judicial system.
