9 Section 905. Disposition of fines and penalties.

10 (a) Disposition.--If a prosecution pursuant to this act is
11 initiated by a State dog warden, employee of the department or
12 State Police officer, all fines forfeited, recognizances and
13 other forfeitures imposed, lost or forfeited under this act
14 shall be payable through the Department of Agriculture into the
15 State Treasury for credit to the Dog Law Restricted Account. If
16 a prosecution pursuant to this act is initiated by a local
17 police officer or animal control officer, all fines forfeited,
18 recognizances and other forfeitures imposed, lost or forfeited
19 under this act shall be payable to the political subdivision
20 which employs such local police officer or animal control
21 officer.

22 (b) Deposits.--Beginning on the effective date of this
23 subsection, fines, fees or costs which are allocated by State
24 law or otherwise directed to the department under this act shall
25 not be deposited in the Judicial Computer System Augmentation
26 Account under 42 Pa.C.S. § 3733(a) (relating to deposits into
27 account).
