- 3 full voting representation in the United States House of
- 4 Representatives; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 6 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorializes the United States
- 7 Congress to adopt a joint resolution proposing to amend the
- 8 United States Constitution by providing full voting
- 9 representation for the District of Columbia in the United States
- 10 House of Representatives and to submit said resolution to the
- 11 states for their ratification; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to the
- 13 presiding officers of the United States Senate and the United
- 14 States House of Representatives and to each United States
- 15 Senator and Representative from Pennsylvania.
