1 WHEREAS, The District of Columbia is not a state; and

2 WHEREAS, The people of the District of Columbia should have

3 full voting representation in the United States House of

4 Representatives; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the

6 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorializes the United States

7 Congress to adopt a joint resolution proposing to amend the

8 United States Constitution by providing full voting

9 representation for the District of Columbia in the United States

10 House of Representatives and to submit said resolution to the

11 states for their ratification; and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be sent to the

13 presiding officers of the United States Senate and the United

14 States House of Representatives and to each United States

15 Senator and Representative from Pennsylvania.
