A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of April 27 through May 4, 1986, as
2 "Students Against Driving Drunk Week."

3 WHEREAS, Injury from alcohol-caused automobile crashes is the
4 number one health problem of today's teenagers; and

5 WHEREAS, Over 100 high schools throughout the eastern states
6 have organized Students Against Driving Drunk (SADD) chapters;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, The SADD program is based on a belief that as more
9 and more teenagers become aware of the statistics and realities
10 of the problems caused by teenage drunk driving, they will take
11 the necessary leadership steps to prevent teenage drunk driving;
12 therefore be it

13 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the week of April 27
14 through May 4, 1986, be designated as "Students Against Driving
15 Drunk Week" to promote and support the efforts of SADD chapters.
