## AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the 1 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for an additional judge in the fifteenth judicial district. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 911(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 911. Courts of common pleas. 9 General rule. -- There shall be one court of common pleas 10 for each judicial district of this Commonwealth consisting of 11 the following number of judges:
