## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, 2 as amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, 3 and third class, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships of the first and second classes including those within a county 4 5 of the second class and counties of the second through eighth 6 classes, individually or jointly, to plan their development and to govern the same by zoning, subdivision and land 7 8 development ordinances, planned residential development and 9 other ordinances, by official maps, by the reservation of certain land for future public purpose and by the acquisition 10 of such land; to promote the conservation of energy through 11 the use of planning practices and to promote the effective 12 13 utilization of renewable energy sources; providing for the 14 establishment of planning commissions, planning departments, planning committees and zoning hearing boards, authorizing 15 16 them to charge fees, make inspections and hold public hearings; providing for mediation; providing for transferable 17 18 development rights; providing for appropriations, appeals to 19 courts and penalties for violations; and repealing acts and 20 parts of acts," further providing for the bonding time period 21 to secure structural integrity.
- 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. Section 509(k) of the act of July 31, 1968
- 25 (P.L.805, No.247), known as the Pennsylvania Municipalities
- 26 Planning Code, reenacted and amended December 21, 1988
- 27 (P.L.1329, No.170), is amended to read:

- 1 Section 509. Completion of Improvements or Guarantee Thereof
- 2 Prerequisite to Final Plat Approval. --\* \* \*
- 3 (k) Where the governing body accepts dedication of all or
- 4 some of the required improvements following completion, the
- 5 governing body may require the posting of financial security to
- 6 secure structural integrity of said improvements as well as the
- 7 functioning of said improvements in accordance with the design
- 8 and specifications as depicted on the final plat for a term not
- 9 to exceed [18] 36 months from the date of acceptance of
- 10 dedication. Said financial security shall be of the same type as
- 11 otherwise required in this section with regard to installation
- 12 of such improvements, and the amount of the financial security
- 13 shall not exceed 15% of the actual cost of installation of said
- 14 improvements.

- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
