- 6 for online retail purchases; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Small business in this Commonwealth has long been
- 8 the key cog in our engine of economic growth; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Small businesses are the backbone of our economy and
- 10 the glue that holds our communities together; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Small businesses are the leading job creators in
- 12 America; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Thanksgiving weekend is traditionally the kickoff of
- 14 the holiday shopping season and is vitally important to our
- 15 local retailers; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 17 November 26, 2011, as "Small Business Saturday" and urge
- 18 Pennsylvanians to give special consideration to patronizing
