## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and 2 malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating 3 and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and 4 restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 5 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic 7 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 8 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing 10 for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 12 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain 13 nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 15 16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," in 17 licenses and regulations, providing for reporting of changes in officers, directors or stockholders. 18 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 20 hereby enacts as follows: The act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known Section 1.

- 22 as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended June 29, 1987 (P.L.32,
- 23 No.14), is amended by adding a section to read:
- 24 Section 415. Reporting of Changes in Officers, Directors or
- 25 Stockholders. -- (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in
- paragraph (2), a corporation, association or other board-26

- 1 <u>licensed entity, except a club, having officers, directors or</u>
- 2 stockholders shall report a change in an officer, director or
- 3 <u>stockholder within fifteen days.</u>
- 4 (2) A change in a stockholder involving less than ten per
- 5 <u>centum of outstanding voting stock need not be reported, except</u>
- 6 when the change involves a majority or controlling interest.
- 7 (3) For purposes of this subsection, "control" is defined as
- 8 the power or authority to manage, direct, govern, administer or
- 9 <u>oversee the operation of a licensed business.</u>
- 10 (b) The changes shall be reported on forms which will be
- 11 <u>furnished upon request by the board. For a change in</u>
- 12 stockholder, an affidavit describing, in detail, the source of
- 13 <u>funds used to purchase the stock shall accompany the form. If</u>
- 14 funds to purchase the stock are derived from a written financing
- 15 agreement, the financing agreement shall be included with the
- 16 form.
- 17 (c) (1) A change of officer of a club shall be reported
- 18 with the renewal of the club license on forms furnished by the
- 19 <u>board upon request.</u>
- 20 (2) Change of club manager or steward shall be reported with
- 21 the renewal of the club license and at license validation on
- 22 forms furnished by the board upon request.
- 23 <u>(d) (1) Change of officer forms for club licensees shall be</u>
- 24 accompanied by a fee of forty dollars (\$40.00). When a
- 25 <u>background investigation is conducted to obtain or verify</u>
- 26 information regarding a change of officer of a club, an
- 27 <u>additional fee of sixty dollars (\$60.00), for a total fee of one</u>
- 28 hundred dollars (\$100.00), shall be assessed.
- 29 (2) Change of officer forms for a change of an officer,
- 30 other than a club, shall be accompanied by a fee of two hundred

- 1 dollars (\$200.00) when the change of officer does not constitute
- 2 <u>a change in majority or controlling interest. If the change of</u>
- 3 <u>officer constitutes a change in majority or controlling</u>
- 4 <u>interest</u>, the fee shall be assessed in accordance with section
- 5 614-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as
- 6 "The Administrative Code of 1929."
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
