## AN ACT

- Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending 3 and consolidating the law relating to boroughs, " further 4 providing for investment of funds. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 1316(c)(vii) of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, added December 13, 1982 (P.L.1145, No.261), is amended to read: 10 Section 1316. Investment of Funds. -- \* \* \* 11 (c) Authorized types of investments for borough funds shall 12 be: 13 14 Any investment authorized by 20 Pa.C.S. Ch.73 15 (relating to [fiduciaries] municipalities investments) shall be an authorized investment for any pension or retirement fund[.] 16
