AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for all motor vehicles to be
3 equipped with a fire extinguisher.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 4528 of Title 75, act of November 25,
7 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes, added June 17, 1976 (No.81), is amended to read:

9 § 4528. Fire extinguishers.

10 Every [vehicle towing a house trailer, every motor home and
11 every] motor vehicle [with a mounted truck-camper] shall be
12 equipped with at least one fire extinguisher of a type and size
13 approved by the department.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately or July 1,
15 1977 and shall apply to every motor vehicle inspected after the
16 effective date.
