1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for learners' permits.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 1505(e) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 1505. Learners' permits.

9	(e) Authorization to test for driver's license and junior
10	driver's licenseA person with a learner's permit is
11	authorized to take the examination for a regular or junior
12	driver's license for the class of vehicle for which a permit is
13	held. Before a person under the age of 18 years may take the
14	examination for a junior driver's license, the minor must:
15	(1) Have held a learner's permit for that class of
16	vehicle for a period of six months or be able to demonstrate
17	to the satisfaction of the department a minimum of six months

1 <u>of out-of-State practical driving experience</u>.

2 (2) Present to the department a certification form 3 signed by the father, mother, guardian, person in loco parentis or spouse of a married minor stating that the minor 4 5 applicant has completed 50 hours of practical driving experience accompanied as required under subsection (b). 6 7 Submission of a certification shall not subject the parent, 8 guardian, person in loco parentis or spouse of a married 9 minor to any liability based upon the certification.

10 (3) Have the certification form completed when the minor 11 is ready for the licensing examination. The certification 12 form shall be developed by the department and will be 13 provided by the department when the original application for 14 a learner's permit is processed. The department will make 15 this form readily available through the mail or electronic 16 means.
