## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for defiant 3 trespasser. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 3503(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 § 3503. Criminal trespass. 8 9 10 (b) Defiant trespasser.--A person commits an offense if, knowing that he is 11 12 not licensed or privileged to do so, he enters or remains in 13 any place as to which notice against trespass is given by: (i) actual communication to the actor; or 14 15 (ii) posting in a manner prescribed by law or reasonably likely to come to the attention of intruders; 16 17 or 18 (iii) fencing or other enclosure manifestly designed

- 1 to exclude intruders.
- 2 (2) An offense under [this] subsection (b)(1)(i), (ii)
- 3 <u>and (iii)</u> constitutes a misdemeanor of the third degree if
- 4 the offender defies an order to leave personally communicated
- 5 to him by the owner of the premises or other authorized
- 6 person. Otherwise it is a summary offense.
- 7 (3) A person commits a misdemeanor of the third degree
- 8 if, knowing that he is not licensed or privileged to do so,
- 9 <u>he enters onto the property of another for the purpose of</u>
- 10 <u>burning a cross for any reason.</u>

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
