- 1 Memorializing the Congress of the United States to reevaluate 2 state motor vehicle emission standards.
- 3 WHEREAS, Section 206 of the Clean Air Act (69 Stat. 1, 42
- 4 U.S.C. § 7525) requires Federal emissions testing; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Section 209 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. § 7543)
- 6 regulates state standards; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Motor vehicles currently in service are newer models
- 8 than in the past; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Testing is expensive and unable to guarantee
- 10 improved air quality; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
- 12 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of
- 13 the United States to reevaluate sections 206 and 209 of the
- 14 Clean Air Act (69 Stat. 1, 42 U.S.C. §§ 7525 and 7543) in light
- 15 of technological improvements and testing costs, goals and
- 16 success; and be it further
