- 3 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Daniel A. Dailey is a native of
- 4 Palmerton, Pennsylvania, and a graduate of the Palmerton High
- 5 School Class of 1990; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey holds a Bachelor of Science
- 7 degree, Summa Cum Laude, from Excelsior College; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey enlisted in the Army in 1989
- 9 attending basic training and advanced individual training as a
- 10 118 Infantryman at Fort Benning, Georgia; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey has held every enlisted
- 12 leadership position in the mechanized infantry, ranging from
- 13 Bradley Fighting Vehicle Commander to Command Sergeant Major;
- 14 and
- 15 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey was sworn in as the 15th

- 1 Sergeant Major of the Army on January 30, 2015; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey is a graduate of class 54 of
- 3 the United States Army Sergeants Major Academy and the Command
- 4 Sergeants Major Course; and
- 5 WHEREAS, As Sergeant Major of the Army, Sergeant Major Dailey
- 6 was the Army Chief of Staff's personal adviser on matters
- 7 affecting the enlisted force; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey devoted the majority of his
- 9 time traveling throughout the Army to observe training and talk
- 10 with soldiers and their families; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey, the public face of the United
- 12 States Army's Noncommissioned Officer Corps, was routinely
- 13 invited to testify before the Congress of the United States and
- 14 represented the corps to America in the media and through
- 15 business and community engagements; and
- 16 WHEREAS, During his career, Sergeant Major Dailey has served
- 17 with the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Infantry Divisions stateside and
- 18 overseas; and
- 19 WHEREAS, In March 2009, Sergeant Major Dailey was selected as
- 20 the 4th Infantry Division Command Sergeant Major serving as both
- 21 the Command Sergeant Major of Fort Carson, Colorado, and United
- 22 States Division North, Iraq; and
- 23 WHEREAS, In 2011, Sergeant Major Dailey was selected to serve
- 24 as the Command Sergeant Major of the United States Army Training
- 25 and Doctrine Command; and
- 26 WHEREAS, In addition to four tours in support of Operations
- 27 Iraqi Freedom and New Dawn, Sergeant Major Dailey deployed in
- 28 support of Operations Desert Storm and Desert Shield; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey earned the Bronze Star with
- 30 Valor for his leadership during the 4th Infantry Division's two-

- 1 month Battle for Sadr City in 2008; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey's military and civilian
- 3 education includes all levels of the Noncommissioned Officer
- 4 Education System, the Bradley Master Gunner Course, the Force
- 5 Management Course and the Keystone Course; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey's awards include the
- 7 Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit (2nd award), Bronze
- 8 Star Medal with Valor, Bronze Star Medal (4th award),
- 9 Meritorious Service Medal (2nd award), Army Commendation Medal
- 10 (7th award), Army Achievement Medal (10th award), Good Conduct
- 11 Medal (9th award), National Defense Service Medal (2nd award),
- 12 Southwest Asia Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal (one silver
- 13 and two bronze service stars), Global War on Terrorism
- 14 Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal,
- 15 Korea Defense Service Medal, Noncommissioned Officer
- 16 Professional Development Ribbon (6th award), Army Service
- 17 Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon (6th award), Kuwait Liberation
- 18 Medal (Kuwait), Kuwait Liberation Medal (Saudi Arabia), Combat
- 19 Infantryman Badge, Expert Infantryman Badge, Ranger Tab and
- 20 Drivers Badge; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Sergeant Major Dailey is a member of the Order of
- 22 Saint Maurice, Centurion level, and the Distinguished Audie
